

cottages, or campsite. Relax and take in the serenity or walk the perimeter of the entire island. The beautiful winding coastal path takes approximately two hours to walk and offers breath-taking scenery, wildlife, and the magical colour variance of the sea.

The Trident ferry arrives and departs at Rosaire steps (half tide down and below) or Herm Harbour (half tide up and above), adjacent to Herm's tiny village where you'll find The White House Hotel, The Ship Inn, Mermaid Tavern and The Herm Shop. St Tugual's Chapel and Manor Cottages are situated at the top of Harbour Hill from where you can enjoy stunning rural views. Delightful leafy walks from the top of this hill will lead you down to Belvoir Bay, Shell Beach and across the wide open common to Bear's Beach and Fisherman's Beach.
