



There really is no place like Herm! Just 3 miles east of St Peter Port Harbour, only 20 minutes by Travel Trident ferry, you will discover the jewel in the Channel Island crown, with no cars, no crowds and no stress - Herm has something for everyone.

Enjoy beautiful beaches and stunning scenery whilst exploring the natural coastline. Take in the spectacular panoramic views of the neighbouring islands and the coastline of France on clear days. Herm is perfect for a day trip or stay awhile in the hotel, cottages, or campsite.

The beautiful winding coastal path takes approximately two hours to walk and offers breath-taking scenery, wildlife, and the magical colour variance of the sea. From Harbour Village a delightful walk takes you along Fisherman's Bay and Bear's Beach and across the wide open common to Shell Beach or Belvoir Bay where you can enjoy a refreshing swim, a stroll on the soft sand and refreshments at the beach cafes (open seasonally).

St Tugual's Chapel sits at the top of Harbour Hill from where you can enjoy stunning rural and sea views.

The Trident ferry arrives and departs at Rosaire steps (half tide down and below) or Herm Harbour (half tide up and above), adjacent to Herm's tiny village where you will find The Ship Inn, Mermaid Tavern and Conservatory Restaurant at The White House Hotel, as well as The Herm Shop, a treasure trove of goodies.
