# **JANUARY & FEBRUARY 2012**

During January and February we offer a limited daily service, (except on a Sunday in January) departing early morning and returning late afternoon. In addition an extra sailing is offered at midday on a Wednesday.

Winter can be a beautiful time to visit Herm, however The White House Hotel is closed for annual maintenance and the Mermaid Tavern (closed in January) is only open on certain days (normally Wednesday and Saturday). 
